- 1.year students work 1 day a week
- The best students get to work in a high quality company
- What the companies want from a student:
  - 1. no absence
  - 2. good behavior
  - 3. participated in pysical education
  - 4. passed the subjects. Grades not important



- 2.second year students work two days a week
- Also three weeks in the fall and again in the spring. Most students (70-80%) signs contracts as apprentices after this. If not, they «are their own».
- Teacher visits them during these two periods. The workplace talks to the teacher after the work-placement. No or little paperwork.
- Many companies need apprentices, but they think they should be workers, not learners for very long.



- The teacher said:
  - Matching the company and the student is important.
- Our school needs to have partnerships with some large companies. Nothing is formal at the moment.
- Now too much is dependent on the teacher:
  - His knowledge about companies in the city
  - His friends/contacts in companies
